

Note for PRF-ZOUZOUS CLASSES

Chers parents,

Thank you for registering your child in our Pre-Zouzous class that meets once a week for a duration of 45 minutes. We will make sure she/he as well as YOU will enjoy a great experience with us, à la française...

And of course, your help is greatly appreciated as you are part of your child's learning process and because you attend the class with your child.

Here are few advices and information that will improve your child's experience in the class:

Routine: each lesson is divided into different times (free playing time, greetings ritual, activities, snack time, activities and goodbye ritual). Children are learning French through age appropriate activities including playing, listening to nursery rhymes, singing, dancing, arts & crafts and storytelling. A great focus is also made on motor skills. For the snack time, we ask you to provide the following:

- · wet wipes to clean hands before eating
- a bottle of water
- a small healthy snack like a piece of fruit, cereals or a few organic biscuits

Classes are conducted in French **only** for a greater immersion. Children and parents are encouraged to interact. **The active participation of all leads to better results**. Even if your child does not speak much yet, just be patient, it will come one day! Be confident: you are the best model for her/him.

Regularity is essential in any learning process, especially for the youngest ones. It is essential for them not to miss any classes (except for medical reasons). If your child has fever, please do not attend the class. If a child seems sick, the teacher will do a temperature check.

Punctuality is very important too. 45 minutes is a short time. Children need to feel secured by following the same routine at each lesson. Missing part of it can make them feel aside and stressed.

Toilets: please make sure your child goes to the bathroom <u>BEFORE</u> the class starts in order to avoid interruptions. If your child is still wearing pampers, please make sure she/he has a clean one when coming to class and a spare one in her/his bag.
